Thank you to the parents who attended our parent forum. Issues that were raised/discussed:

Discussion Point	Notes
1. Football Team	With Mr Riley leaving, who would run the Football team? PB explained that Mr Carter run the football team in September
2. Uniform	Will the uniform change in September? PB referred parents to the FAQ on the Academy website regarding Academy changes. Only the uniform logo will change but that will be a gradual process. Parents are not expected to buy new uniform straight away. PB also explained the changes to the Senior Leadership Team titles as stated above. The academy will also adapt the Believe Achieve Succeed vision.
3. Transition	Will you have the 2-week transition? Yes, this will be the same as last year. Children have the opportunity to settle in their new classes with their teacher. They will begin their new curriculum. It was a success last year, children are settled and look forward to September.
4. Ofsted	Are there going to be any changes to the school after the Ofsted report? There will not be any changes but will ensure that the outcomes for children are the best that we can achieve at Ash Croft. Mobility is high and we are finding children joining and leaving the Academy. Only 70 children live in the catchment area. The children that stay with us through KS2 achieve the expected standard or greater depth at the end of KS2.
5. Sports Day	Comment: Sports day this year was well organised and it was a delight to watch.
