What have each class been learning about this week?

Class	
Oak	This week in Science, the children have been naming a variety of common animals linked to our talk for writing text ' I love animals.'
Pine	This week in Maths, the children have been learning to count in 2s, 5s, 3s and 10s.
Willow	This week in Maths, the children have been learning how to add in multiples of 100.
Birch	This week in English, the children have been writing their own adventure stories.
Maple	This week in Maths, the children have been using the column method to add numbers up to 100,000.
Elm	This week in English, the children have been writing a non-chronological report on animals who live in the forest, linked to our Topic work.
Sycamore	This week in Dance, the children have been dancing to the beat of 8, using different emotions and at different levels.
